「傳播是為建立真實的相遇文化而服務」

文目 愛的兄弟姊妹們,

今天我們生活在一個越變越「小」的世界。正因如此, 我們全體似乎更加容易比鄰而居。交通與傳播科技的發達, 使我們彼此更加緊密,更加息息相關,甚至全球化也使我們 更加互相依賴。但是,分裂,有時是極深的分裂,依舊存在 於我們人類家庭當中。從全球的角度,我們看到富人的鉅富 與窮人的赤貧之間,是令人憤慨的鴻溝。通常我們只需要走 在城市街頭,就可以看到這樣的對比,一邊是流浪街頭的遊 民,一邊是商店櫥窗燦亮的燈光。我們已太習慣見到這樣的 景象,以至於不再令我們感到不安。我們的世界正承受許多 形式的排擠、邊緣化與貧窮,更別提混合了經濟、政治、意 識形態的種種衝突,而不幸地,甚至也包含宗教因素所帶來 的衝突。 在這樣的世界裡,媒體可以幫助我們感覺彼此更靠近, 創造人類家庭的一體感,這一體感能啟迪給我們精誠團結, 激發我們為保障全體人類更有尊嚴的生活而認真努力。良好 的傳播幫助我們更靠近,更了解彼此,並且最終在合一中成 長。分隔我們的圍牆是可以被粉碎的,但我們一定要準備好 去聆聽對方和彼此學習。我們需要透過種種對話,解決我們 之間的分歧,這會幫助我們彼此了解、相互尊重。一種「相 遇的文化」要求我們不只願意去給予,也要願意來接受。媒 體在這方面可以給予我們大力的援助,特別是今天,人類溝 通的網絡已達到前所未有的進展。尤其是網際網路,能為團 結互助與彼此相遇提供無限的機會。這真是件好事,是來自 天主的恩賜。

這不是說,沒有一些問題存在。資訊流通的速度,超出我們反省與判斷的能力,無法帶來較為平衡、準確的自我表達方式。眾說紛紜的各種意見,可以被視為是助力,但也可能使人自我封鎖在只肯定自己的想法、希望,或政治與經濟利益的各種資訊背後。擁有傳播的世界,可以幫助我們拓展知識,也可能讓我們迷失方向。對數位聯繫的渴望,也會產生使我們與最靠近的鄰人隔離的作用。我們不該忽略這個事實:那些不論什麼原因無法享用大眾媒體的人,常遇到被人遺忘的情況。

雖然這屬事實,但不足以構成拒絕大眾媒體的理由;這反而些提醒我們,傳播終究在於「人」,而非科技的成就。那麼,在一個數位環境中,究竟是什麼能幫助我們在人道與相互了解上有所成長呢?舉例來說,我們需要找回一種審慎和冷靜的態度。這樣的態度需要時間,需要聆聽與靜默的能力。如果我們想要了解與我們不同的人,也要有耐心。人們只有在不是單單被容忍,而是真正被接納之時,他們才會完

全地表達自己。如果我們真正專注地聆聽他人,我們會學到以 不同的眼光看世界,開始欣賞人類經驗在不同文化與傳統中顯 現出來的多姿多采。我們也會學著,更全面地來欣賞基督信仰 所鼓勵的重要價值觀,例如,基督信仰對人的看法、家庭與婚 姻的本質、宗教與政治場域適當的分際、團結互助與上下輔助 (subsidiarity)的原則,以及其他許多價值。

那麼,傳播要怎樣去為真實的相遇文化服務呢?我們身為 主的門徒,在福音之光的啟迪下和他人相遇,又是什麼意思? 儘管我們自己有限度和受到罪的影響,我們要怎樣真正地和彼 此更加靠近?這些問題,歸結起來,就是一位經師——一位傳 訊者——曾問過耶穌的:「誰是我的近人?」(路10:29)這 個問題可以幫助我們,用「鄰近」這一角度來看傳播。我們可 以把這個問題改寫成這樣:我們如何利用傳播媒體,在數位科 技打造的新環境下,彼此變得鄰近?我在善良的撒瑪黎雅人這 個比喻裡找到了答案,這也是一個與傳播有關的比喻。那些行 傳播的人,實際上,也成為近人。善良的撒瑪黎雅人,不只是 靠近了在路邊半死半活的那位;他還為他負起了責任。耶穌轉 移了我們理解的核心:不只該「視人若己」,更要能「視己若 人」。傳播真正的目的,在於使人明瞭我們大家都是人類的一 分子、天主的子女。我喜歡將傳播的這種力量定義為「使人變 得鄰折」。

當傳播主要的目的成了推廣消費,或者操縱他人,我們就 在面臨一種粗暴的侵略,猶如比喻中那個人被強盜擊傷、棄置 路邊所遭受攻擊。肋未人和司祭沒有將他看作近人,視他為陌 生人而保持距離。那時候,是因為宗教儀式取潔方面的規定, 限制了他們的反應。今天,則有一種危險,就是某些媒體侷限 了我們有所回應,以至於我們無法看見自己直下的折人。

在數位科技的公路上,只是當個過路、保持「連線中」的 人,這是不夠的;連結需要在直正的相遇中成長。我們不能各 過各的,與外隔絕。我們需要去愛和被愛。我們需要關懷。媒 體的運作策略不保證傳播出真、善、美。媒體世界也應該要關 注人道,也有使命去呈現出人情。數位世界也可以成為富於人 道的環境,不再只是用電纜,而是由人構成的網絡。媒體的中 立只是一種外貌;唯有在傳播訊息的過程中,走出自身之外的 那些人,才能夠確實為他人表達真相。個人的委身才是傳播工 作者可靠的基礎。藉由網路,基督徒的見證得以直達人生邊緣 的地帶。

如同我一再說過的,一個走上街頭負著傷的教會,或一 個只專注自身的教會,兩者中必須做出選擇時,我必然選擇前 者。「街頭」就是人們生活的地方、讓教會可以有效地和有情 感地觸接他們的地方。數位公路正是其中之一,是人們聚集的 「街頭」,這些人們往往是抱著痛苦、正想尋找拯救或希望的 男男女女。诱過網路,基督信仰的訊息可以達到「地極」(宗 一8)。讓教堂的門保持敞開,也是對數位環境保持開放,這 樣,無論在生命何種處境的人們都可以走強來,而福音也能向 外接觸到每一個人。我們蒙受召叫去體現,教會是所有人的 家。我們是否足以能通傳教會的此種形象?傳播是表達整個教 會傳教使命的一項工具;今天,社會網絡是體驗這份召叫的一 種方式——去發現信仰的美、與基督相遇的美。在傳播的領 域,我們也需要一個能夠帶來溫暖、鼓舞人心的教會。

有效的基督信仰見證,不是用宗教的訊息對人們疲勞轟 炸,而是願意向他人開放,「耐心並尊敬地回覆他人在尋求真 理與人生意義時所遇到的問題與疑惑」(本篤十六世,2013年 第四十七屆世界傳播節文告)。我們只要回想一下厄瑪鳥門徒 的故事。我們必須能和今日的男女對話,了解他們的期待、疑

慮與希望,把福音帶給她們,也就是耶穌基督自己,降生成人的天主,死而復活,從死亡和罪惡中釋放我們的那一位。我們被挑戰要成為具有深度的人,專注於我們周遭所發生一切,在靈性上保持警醒。交談,這意味著去相信「他人」所說的總具有某些價值,並且去思考他/她的觀點和角度。與人交談,不是否定自己的想法和傳統,而是不堅持只有自己的想法和傳統才是正確或絕對的。

願善良的撒瑪黎雅人,那位替受傷者在傷口處抹上酒與油、加以包紮的這個圖像鼓舞我們。讓我們傳播的訊息成為舒緩疼痛的油膏和使心靈雀躍的美酒。願我們帶給他人的光不是來自妝扮和特效,而是來自我們對那些受了傷、被丟在路邊的人所表達的愛與仁慈。讓我們勇敢地成為數位世界的公民。教會必須關心,也必須出現在傳播的世界,好能和今天的人們對話,幫助他們與基督相遇。她必須成為站在他人身旁的教會,能夠陪伴著每一位在旅途上的人。傳播媒體與資訊科技上所發生的革命,代表了一項重大而令人興奮的挑戰;願我們用嶄新的活力與想像力,在試著與他人分享天主的美善時,回應這項挑戰。

代辦致詞:

- 代辦分享教宗方濟各今年2 月27日在梵蒂岡波隆那大堂 裡向宗座主教部的成員的訓誨 (參閱附件):教宗提醒被主 耶穌召叫當主教的弟兄們聖德 的重要性,以及身為牧者必須 培養出來的某些美德。
- 主教團要提供教廷三位未來 主教候選人人名。

- 堂區四大聖事冊電子化,不 能代替紙本的紀錄,只能用以 方便搜尋。
- 主教團應委派神父參加香港 由湯漢樞機主教領導的培訓小 組委員會,以準備面對人數與 日俱增的大陸在外地進修的神 父、修女及教友。
- 傳信部參考其它亞洲地方教會主教團之後,批准主教團「變更財物的總價值最高額」為US\$2,000,000.00。
- 傳信部提供獎學金,但必須 要遵守申請規則及時限。

- 主教們處理神職人員性侵害 案件時,態度必須要認真嚴 謹,一定要遵守地方法令規 定,知道案件發生後就有責任 涌報警方。在調查的過程中, 主教必須宣布被告的神職人員 暫時停職。若證明有罪,該神 職人員必須按照教廷規定免其 神職,而主教應關心受害者及 其家人,以及被判刑的神職人 員及其家人。若被告的神職人 員被證明是清白的,主教必須 公開宣布, 並恢復其神職及撫 慰其心靈創傷,幫助該無辜神 職人員早日正常地在教會裡服 務。
- 教宗本篤十六世說過三個關於因同性傾向而不能進修院的阻礙: 有根深蒂固同性傾向的、無法保持貞潔最少三年以上,以及積極推動同性運動的男子,都不能當司鐸候選人。
- 《天主教法典》的修定版乃 是一重要工程,需要與港澳合作,確保其中文翻譯內容正確 無誤,然後提供給梵蒂岡。
- 大使館在維修期間會暫時遷

移到台北教區成功新村天 主堂(和平東路2段265巷9 號),但電話號碼將不會改 變(02.2321-6847)。

本法人已於100年2月21日經貴部內授中民字第1000030764號函備查,新建「天主教會台灣主教團總修院」工程已於本年完工並取得建物所有權狀,新建經費由建物保留款支付。(94年度結餘經費納入財產總額,已於98年8月4日財北國稅審一字第098007474號函核備)本案業以執行完成,依程序辦理財產變更。如增減財產明細表。

二、本法人原總修院拆除完竣辦理財產減少變更本法人已於102年5月30日經貴部台內民字第1020213497號函備查在案,本法人所屬坐落新北市泰山區3小段450、451、452、453、454等5筆地號

上土地三層建物(新北市泰山區貴子路69號)拆除。本案拆除完竣,辦理財產減少變更。

提案E、《天主教大學 憲章在台實行準則》 (《Norms for the Application of the Apostolic Constitution "Ex Corde Ecclesiae" in Taiwan》)中文翻譯。

說明:《天主教大學憲章 在台實行準則》(《Norms for the Application of the Apostolic Constitution "Ex Corde Ecclesiae" in Taiwan》)中文版生效前,需 得主教團正式通過。但輔 大董事會18屆第7次會議指 出,《天主教大學憲章在台 實行準則》(第四條1及5 項、)英文版裡的「chancellor」及「vice-chancellor」,中文翻釋為「校長」及「副校長」,不肯定意思是否正確。該重要職位的中文翻譯需要確認。2013秋季會議臨時動議決議為「修正通過」。

事後,祕書長跟大使館 (桑神父)溝通,結論為: 在義大利的天主教大學,督 導人(cancelliere)通常是該 地方的[樞機]主教,其責任 為確保該[宗座]大學遵守天 主教大學憲章辦學、管理, 學校精神/文化符合天主教 會傳統/文化。

大使館認為,此文件乃 是主教團自訂文件,故主 教團可自己指定誰去承擔 第四條1項裡「維護並強 化本身天主教的身定其分 責任,然後再決定,如 新主教(Local ordinary), 學校董事長(President of the Board of trustees) 或校長(Chancellor)。 此外,第四條5項英文原 文為:「The Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor of a Catholic Higher Education Institution are to be <u>practicing Catholics</u> of distinguished character.」其含意清楚地指平信徒,而非主教或神職人員。

提案F、主教團2015年牧 函。

說明:教廷已公布2015年為「獻身生活年」(World Day for Consecrated Life)。3/31主教與修會會長合作會議決議2015年牧函以「奉獻生活為新福傳服務」為主題。而2/2是獻身生活日。故要儘早請累好會代表提供有關「獻身生活」思考的內容中,以及教區與修會具體合作行動。

決議:委託詹德隆神父 (耶穌會)負責統籌及主 編工作,秋季會議報告。

提案**G**、建立國外講師來台 灣地方教會演講審核[認證]

機制。

說明:若國外平信徒想回台作專題演講,目前做法是自己找在不同教區認識的朋友(善善會組織幹部)替他安排策劃行程及安排場地。為確保講者本人和其有關教義、靈修、倫理、道德等的內容,都不會誤導教友們,主教團或各教區有必要建立一審核機制、訂定審核標準,以避免造成混亂,甚至傷害。

辦法:各教區按照地方需要 自定審核機制。

決議:祕書處收集外國主教 團做法作參考,秋季會議報 告。

提案單位二: 禮儀委員會

提案A:建議各教區成立教 區層級的聖體敬禮推廣小 組。

說明:主教團禮委會已成立 聖體敬禮推廣小組,在推廣

的過程中,企需教區有一專 責小組或負責人,以便聯繫 和有利推廣。

辦法:各教區實行2012年主教團秋季常年大會所通過的禮委會提案A:有關聖體的禮委會提案A:有關聖體的禮推廣和聖體聖事的培育,以及舉辦全國性的聖體大會;其中的「辦法二、為達致目標,建議各教區的實況,透過禮儀委員會或牧靈委員會組成「聖體推廣小組」,或指派一人專事負責。」

決議:通過。

提案B:建議各教區推動善 終祝禱團。

說明:善終祝禱團的目的: 為能以平信徒的身份,作為 服務教會團體的見證。以復 活的主耶穌為中心,並打開 我們的心房接受主的恩寵。 透過信友們的通功代禱,把 臨終者交託在天父手裡。陪 伴亡者親友一起深化對基督 逾越的信仰。信賴天主的救 恩,表達與亡者的共融,以 及期待末日在天鄉重逢。從 服務過程中,尋找福傳的契 機。

辦法:主教團禮委會善終祝 禱小組可按各教區的需要, 提供培訓課程,以及分享組 織及運作經驗。各教區如有 需要,可與主教團禮委會善 終祝禱小組聯繫。

決議:通過。

提案C:針對2012年主教團 春季大會決議通過,並於 同年5月頒布的公告 第十 條,因為禮委會的敘述不正 確或容易產生誤解,特此更 正。條文如下(需要修訂的 句子以斜體並底下畫線標示 出)。

說明:有關非在天主教受洗 的基督徒在天主教會領聖 體,必須要按照《天主教法 典》844條,以及《大公指 南》124和131號行事。因 此,天主教聖職人員只能對 天主教信徒,合法地施行聖

事;同樣天主教信徒,只能 由天主教聖職人員合法地領 受聖事。」(《法典》844 條1項) 但是「如有需要, 或真實神益的要求,只要能 避免錯誤及信仰無差別論的 **危險**,天主教徒在實際或難 以找到天主教聖職人員的情 形下,許可由非天主教的聖 職人員,領受懺悔、聖體和 病人傅油聖事,但上述聖 事須在該教會內有效。」 (《法典》844條2項) 反 之,在相同的情況下,「尚 未完全和天主教會共融的東 方教會人士,如果自動請 求,目亦有相稱的準備,天 主教聖職人員可合法地為之 施行懺悔、聖體和病人傅油 聖事; 此項規定亦適用於其 他教會的人士,但該教會對 聖事的態度,須依聖座的判 斷,一如上述東方教會人士 的情況相同。」(《法典》 844條3項)而尤其是, 「遇死亡為危險時,或依教 區主教或主教團的判斷,認 為有其他迫切要求,天主教 聖職人員亦得為和天主教尚 未完全共融的基督徒,當其

1. 為能提供確認合適人選 接受修院培育, 懇請各教區 按教廷天主教教育聖部在 2005年正式批准並明令頒布的「對有關有同性戀傾向者準備進入修院或晉鐸之聖召之鑑定準則」執行。

2. 按台灣總修院入院申請程序安排,聖召候選者至少應有半年以上的「陪伴期」,若在此時期善加觀察,必能有相關的現象供參考,以利教區決定是否送到修院接受培育。

二、辦法:

提案E、2014司鐸進修班 (8/18-22台灣總修院)。 一、主旨:研習台灣社會 之同性戀現況,教會教導 與立場,及香港牧靈 經 驗分享。

二、說明:

2014年全國聖體大會

「讓小孩子到我跟前來」

[[_次全國聖體大會由天主 **↓└**教台灣地區主教團主 辦、新竹教區承辦、桃園縣政 府指導。聖體聖事是耶穌基督 所建立的,是天主透過教會賜 給世世代代的天上食糧、愛 的信物。天主出於無條件的 愛,派遣了祂的獨子耶穌降生 成人, 在耶穌基督內天人合 一。大會主題取自耶穌在福音 中所說的一句話:「讓小孩子 到我跟前來」(《瑪竇福音》 第19章14節)。「小孩子」代 表最弱小的弟兄姊妹,需要我 們的關懷愛護。我們得成為主 耶穌的手,以耶穌的愛、用我 的手擁抱受苦的弟兄姊妹,用 我們的手撫慰每一顆創傷的心 靈,協助他們度過生命中的每 一個難關。

500多位新竹、桃園地區的志工兄姊已籌備年餘,當天初領聖體的約400多位小朋友,男孩穿白襯衫、紅領帶或領結及深色褲子,女孩穿白色洋裝及頭紗,在要理老師、家

長陪同下,一早就到達現場; 那分喜悅,從他們的笑聲即不 難了解,也從父母的忙碌中顯 示出家庭的重要性,及家庭與 普世教會的連結。

不少教友拂曉即起程,從全台各地不畏風雨兼程趕至桃園巨蛋,並如麵餅般地圍聚在天主的祭桌前,與2000多年前耶穌最後晚餐的奧蹟相連結。且藉由彌撒聖祭、聖體遊行和聖體降福的行動,讓萬人的心與聖體相結合,在主愛內全然獻上與合一。

大會司儀由新竹教區郭世 平副主教及蕭麗卿姊妹擔任, 下午1時在桃園縣長吳志揚的 致詞中活動正式開始,吳縣長 在致詞時先闡釋了本屆聖體大 會的主題標語「讓小孩子到我 跟前來」的意義,說明「小孩 子」並不僅限於真正的年幼稚 子」還包含著所有的需要照 顧的弱勢族群,如身心障等, 要讓這些族群們都能知道感受 到社會上的愛。隨後吳縣長稍 稍提了幾所天主教創辦的機 構,如聖保祿醫院、華光智能 發展中心、天使發展中心等醫 療及社福機構,振聲高中、等醫 療及社福機構,振聲高中、德 來長青大學及多所幼兒園等教 育機構等,並特別感謝聖保祿 醫院沈雅蓮院長,在吳縣長最 需要鼓勵之時,致贈十字架, 並告訴他耶穌的故事,勉勵他 不要放棄對人群的關懷。

隨後,由上智國小的小朋 友們以純真的歌聲及舞蹈做開 場的表演;我們都是在天父的 花園中的朵朵花兒,我們應該 放下自己,信靠天主。接著, 李克勉主教以「快問快答」的 方式,邀請弟兄姊妹上台,詢 問他們為何要來此,做信仰的 對話。

第1位分享的彭正偉弟兄 回答說,每天思考如何活出基 督徒的生活,如何把基督的愛 帶給其他人;帶著兩個女兒的 陳宥樺姊妹回答說,要讓自己 的子女知道,天主給的愛比父 母的愛更多;第3位行動不便 的胡宏松弟兄回答說,從小因 天生的殘缺感覺自卑,但自從 知道了耶穌基督揹負十字架, 便覺得自己所揹負的十字架也成了天主的恩賜。李主教在3位弟兄姊妹回答結束後,以伯多祿在耶穌復活後回答耶穌問他「你愛我嗎?」的回答「主,祢知道我愛祢。」說明,只有主知道的事才是最可靠的。

下一個表演活動是新 竹教區在桃園的3所幼兒 園:德來、瑪利、貞德的歌 舞表演;在主內的每一天, 給我們換一顆感恩的心,懂 得珍惜身邊的事物。

在兒童歌舞表演之 後,上台作見證的是台北總 教區南松山天主堂的主任司 鐸白納德神父。「聖體聖事 是我們恩寵的泉源,因為聖 體聖事我們得以成為耶穌的 腳走向人群,落實耶穌愛的 使命。」法國籍的白納德神 父與大家分享他年輕時在明 供聖體活動中的體驗,促使 他答覆聖召。也因為這樣的 體驗,讓他付出許多心力在 讓兒童參與明供聖體活動 上。兒童無邪的思想,更能 直接藉由聖體感受到耶穌的 臨在,並會在他們心中播下



信仰的種子。

台南教區姜熹弟兄分享「家庭中的信仰」,從母親罹癌開始談起,先是家人懷疑為何信仰堅貞的母親會飽受病症折磨,但母親堅強的信德隨即接受了這項事實,並仍然努力於監獄牧靈,及關懷未婚媽媽、受暴

婦女、失親兒、殘缺兒等事工,憶及如此受主恩寵的母親,姜熹弟兄言詞中一度哽咽,也見證了姜家一家人在「家庭祈禱」下產生的堅強信德。

新竹教區曙光女中的 悠揚聖歌演唱給現場帶來和 緩,優美的合音與莊嚴的氣 氛,讓大家都陶醉在這群 天使們的美妙歌聲中。接 著,嘉義教區黃豐騰弟兄分 享監獄牧靈的經驗:「以我 們的手擁抱所有的弟兄好 妹,協助小兄弟們度過每 一個難關,以成為耶穌的 一個難關,以成為耶穌的 手去助人行善。」領洗10 年後,常感受到天主召叫 他去傳播福音、服務最小 弟兄們,並被「對於一個 罪人悔改,在天上所有的 歡樂,甚於對那九十九個 無須悔改的義人。」(召 15:7)及「我不是來召 人,而是召罪人。」,認為 上記 (認 是 2:17)兩句特別感動,認為 監獄中的收容人特別需要福



音的幫助。投身監獄牧靈的 服務,開設「生涯規劃」的 課程,卻逐漸引導收容人學 員們與主接近。雖然並非所 有學員服刑期滿後都會來到 教堂,但會來到教堂的都是 熱切追求認識主的人。離 監所的收容人或許在適應社 會生活上會有所困難,但藉 著天主的愛,藉著祈禱人與 更生人能夠再次回歸社會, 類 更生人能夠再次回歸社會 東生人能夠再次回歸社會 主。

除了監所收容人外, 也有許多社會中的弱勢族 群。新竹教區的原住民泰雅 族教友林寶貴姊妹分享她服 務這些最小弟兄的經驗:林 姊妹憶及服務弱勢族群的過 程中, 許多原住民弱勢家庭 讓他最為印象深刻。記得有 一次服務一個家庭, 父親 酗酒,母親弱智,她只得教 家庭中的長子煮飯、照顧父 母。多年後孩子長大,成為 了一名教師,有次反問自己 為何自己會生長在這樣的家 庭,但隨後依靠信仰找到了 答案:我們不能選擇自己出 生自哪個家庭,但我們可以 創造不一樣的家庭。林姊妹 藉由服務這些最小弟兄們, 從他們身上看到了耶穌的 千百種不同面貌。

前聖體聖事的奧蹟將所有肢體 無論強弱的都連結至今, 這 餅可小於容於我身,也可大於 全世界,惟有如小孩般的全然 謙卑、信靠,為最小弟兄姊妹 服務,才得進天國。

在台語、客語讀經及洪總主教講道後,初領聖體的小朋友帶著禮儀本和蠟燭走到祭台前,由6位教區小朋友代表從復活蠟點燃基督之光後,再在大修院的修士、主日學老師及志工教師協助下人人都燃起基督之光,與全體教友,在和李克勉主教的溫馨對答中隆重重宣聖洗誓願,並且鏗鏘有力的答應李克勉主教,服從教會的領導。

聖祭禮儀準備餅酒時, 先由台中教區原民青年獻禮遊 行前導,菲律賓、越南和印尼 的新住民代表獻祭台布、七大 教區獻燭圍繞在復活蠟四周, 然後由初領聖體的兒童代表劉 凝和廖顥恩獻餅酒,捧著極大 聖爵的廖顥恩戰戰兢兢邁向祭 台,慎重程度顯示出孩童對初 領聖體的期待。

領聖體時,初領聖體的小朋友成了全場的焦點。400多位小朋友分為4區,由鍾安住主教、李克勉主教、劉振忠總主教和蘇耀文主教在4位神父及輔祭陪同下,送聖體聖血給孩子們。看著原本蹦跳的孩子在聖體前的恭敬,家長和要理老師們盈眶的淚,可見這是何等大事。

領聖體後經後,執事即頒全大赦,洪總主教並以十字架降福大家,全體並為教宗的意向誦念〈信經〉、〈天主經〉及〈聖母經〉,也請尚未辦告解的信友,在8日內領受和好聖

事,以滿全全大赦的條件。

彌撒聖祭後,隨即舉行聖 體遊行及聖體降福,由劉振忠 總主教主禮。劉總主教先脫下 小紅帽、穿上白色圓氅衣,明 供聖體向聖體上香。此時巨蛋 內大部分的燈光都已關上,全 部聚焦在聖體光,全體在靜默 中朝拜聖體,之後執事為主禮 披上披肩,恭捧聖體光開始聖 體遊行,全體保持靜默。

十字架和4位爵士前導, 24位小輔祭手持蠟燭,陪伴 劉總主教恭持聖體光, 並有教 廷駐華陸代辦和8位主教等人 伴隨,在〈我今虔誠朝拜〉歌 聲和輕柔的琴聲中,緩步至第 一站。劉總主教將聖體恭置於 小祭台,全體跪下,主禮向聖 體上香,全體靜默朝拜聖體3 分鐘。台中教區首先獻上禱 詞,祈求親愛的主耶穌,以聖 愛豐富生命,更因愛情聖事進 入我們心中,得著新力與聖 化,足以面對日益嚴酷的家庭 倫理挑戰。嘉義教區則在禱詞 中, 先感謝100多年前藉著外 籍傳教士將福音的種籽撒在嘉 義, 並由聖神陪伴, 使教區內 各事務得成長,今後期更蒙啟

發,積極向外傳播好消息。

十字架和大小輔祭團引 導,在〈阿肋路亞讚美主〉的 歌聲中,隊伍緩步移至由騎士 護衛的第2站。靜默朝拜聖體 後,由台南教區和高雄教區獻 上禱詞。台南教區祈願在天主 祝佑下,教區內更合而為一, 聖體更為教友的旅途之泉,克 制私慾倫情,得生活在主愛 的真福八端内, 光照我們的 眼、開啟我們的心和視野,投 向神聖美善,全然奉獻,步入 屬主的圓融。高雄教區則祈 求在聖神引導台灣福傳150年 後,教友更團結,為8月24日 的傳愛音樂會盡心盡力,讓救 恩的消息更廣傳。

隊伍在〈君王面前〉歌聲中移至第3站時,改由小提琴樂音陪伴隊伍,劉總主教仍將聖體恭置於小祭台,靜默朝拜聖體後,花蓮教區感謝聖體內的耶穌賜予花蓮教區的不同,祈願更多的服事,為合一作見證。台北教區也獻上禱詞,祈以聖體滋養生命,明辨揀選與召叫,在聖體聖事內共享聖神的喜樂,張開雙臂擁抱每一黑暗角落。效法聖子,彼此相

扶持、相親愛,在家庭內更因主愛的澆灌,信仰得成長茁壯。

最後遊行隊伍回主祭台,靜默朝拜聖體後,新竹教區感謝天主的無數恩寵。懇求因新竹教區主保為聖母聖心的轉求,恩賜教區上下聽從聖神的領導,奉獻能力、時間和資源,同心協力實行新竹教區牧靈大會的各項決議,邁向共融與福傳的願景。

聖體降福後,本屆聖體大會承辦單位新竹教區李克勉主教,將大會Logo經由主教團主席洪山川總主教,交給2016年全國聖體大會承辦單位台中教區蘇耀文主教。全體在喜悅中歡唱〈天上母皇歡樂〉,為2014全國聖體大會畫下完美句點,凝聚愛,讓愛火不斷。(摘錄自天主教周報293期)

Procedure of Meeting:

- A) Opening Prayer
- B) Address by Archbishop John Hung, President
- C) Address by Msgr. Paul Russell
- Msgr. Paul Russell shared the address that Pope Francis gave to the members of the Congregation for Bishops on February 27, 2014 in the Sala Bologna of the Vatican Apostolic Palace (see Appendix). The Pope reminded the bishops of the importance of holiness for those chosen by Jesus Christ as bishops, and, as pastors, of the need for formation in virtue.
- The computerization of records for four of the sacraments in the parishes cannot replace paper records. Its purpose is only to facilitate the searching of information.
- The CRBC should appoint a priest to join the sub-commission on formation headed by Cardinal Tong Hon of Hong Kong in order to be prepared to deal with the growing number of priests, sisters and lay people from Mainland China participating in ongoing formation abroad

- After the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples consulted other Asian Bishops' Conferences, it gave approval "to modify the limit of competence for alienation of ecclesiastical properties" to US \$2,000,000.00.
- The Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples offers scholarships, but application procedures and deadlines must be followed.
- When bishops deal with clerical sexual abuse their attitude should be serious and conscientious. They must comply with local laws and regulations, and they have the responsibility of reporting all incidents to the police. During the course of the investigation the bishops must declare the accused clergy temporarily suspended. If proven guilty, following the regulations of the Holy See, the priest must be dismissed from the priesthood. Furthermore, the bishops should show concern for the victims and their families, and for the indicted priest and his family. If the accused priest is proven not guilty, the bishop should make a public announcement, reinstate the priest, aid him in dealing with any trauma he might have experienced and help the innocent priest return to normal Church ministry as soon as possible.
- Pope Benedict XVI said that there are three things that would hinder those
 who have homosexual tendencies from entering the seminary: deep-rooted
 homosexual tendencies, an inability to keep celibate for at least three years,
 and active promotion of the gay rights movement. These conditions are a
 hindrance to candidacy to the priesthood.
- The revised edition of the translation of the Code of Canon Law is a very important project. It is necessary to collaborate with Hong Kong and Macau to ensure that the content of the new Chinese translation is accurate and correct. Afterwards, it should be sent to the Vatican.
- While the Apostolic Nunciature is being repaired the office will be temporarily transferred to The Immaculate Heart of Mary Church in the Taipei Archdiocese (9 Lane 265, Hoping East Road, Section 2, Taipei). The tel. no. will remain unchanged (02.2321-6847).
- All diocesan bishops are asked to submit a yearly financial report of their

diocese to the Apostolic Nunciature. These reports will be sent to the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples.

Proposition V: The Commission for Evangelization, Section for the Family

- V.C: To help the faithful understand what pastoral knowledge is needed to care for homosexuals, the CRBC Section for the Family will organize a seminar in the morning of August 23, 2014 in the 2nd floor conference room of the CRBC Secretariat Administrative Bldg.

VARIA:

1. The Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples approved "to modify the limit of competence for alienation of ecclesiastical properties" to US\$2,000,000.

- 2. One of the resolutions in the 2012 CRBC Autumn Plenary Assembly was: "In principle, once every two or three years a National Eucharistic Congress can be organized. The date and venue of each National Eucharistic Congress will be decided during the CRBC plenary assemblies."
- 3. To reiterate to President Ma Ying-jeou the following stance: "Respect for life, abolish the death penalty".

Proposition I: The CRBC Secretariat

I.A: Audit of the CRBC 2013 Annual Report and 2013 Work Report Explanation:

Refer to the "2013 Final Accounts for Income and Expenditures" and "2013 Work Report" for discussion. After approval, present them to the Ministry of the Interior (see attachment).

Resolution: Approved.

I.B: Request for approval to modify the CRBC total amount of property.

Explanation:

1. The construction of the new building of the CRBC "Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary" has already been completed and a request made to modify the amount of property. The CRBC has already received a letter of approval from the Ministry of the Interior with Ref. No. 1000030764 dated 2011.2.21 stating that the construction of the new building for "Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary" has been completed this year and has acquired the right of ownership. The expenses of the new building will be taken from the funds reserved for the construction. (The balance of funds in 2005 was added to the total amount of property. Received from the National Taxation Bureau of Taipei an official letter with ref no. 098007474 dated 2009.8.4.) This case has already been executed and completed, modifying the amount of property based on the procedure. See

changes in property list.

- 2. The original Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary of the CRBC has been completely demolished and an application made for a reduction in amount of property. The CRBC has received a letter of approval from the Dept. of Land Administration, Ministry of the Interior, with ref. no. 1020213497 dated 2013.5.30 stating that the CRBC three story building located at Subsection 3 of Taishan District, New Taipei City, built on 5 pieces of land 450 \(^1451 \) \(^1452 \) \(^1453 \) \(^1454 \) has been demolished and a reduction made in the amount of property.
- 3. These modifications have increased or reduced the amount of property according to procedure.

Resolution: Approved.

I.C: The Chinese translation of the "Norms for the Application of the Apostolic Constitution

'Ex Corde Ecclesiae' in Taiwan"

Explanation:

Before the Chinese translation of the "Norms for the Application of the Apostolic Constitution 'Ex Corde Ecclesiae' in Taiwan" can be implemented, it is necessary to have the official approval of the CRBC. However, the 7th meeting of Fu Jen Catholic University 18th Board of Directors noted that the English edition Art. 4: 1 and 5 of "Norms for the Application of the Apostolic Constitution 'Ex Corde Ecclesiae' in Taiwan" uses the terms "chancellor" and "vice-chancellor," which are translated into Chinese as "校長" (meaning "President") and "副校長" (meaning "Vice President"). The accuracy of the Chinese translation was uncertain and required confirmation. The resolution during the 2013 Autumn Plenary was: "Approved after the necessary changes are completed."

Later, Fr. Otfried Chan discussed the issue with Fr. Ivan Santus of the Apostolic Nunciature and the following conclusions were made: In the Catholic universities in Italy the term "Chancellor" usually refers to the "Cardinal" or the Local Ordinary, whose responsibility it is to ensure that the "Pontifical" Universities comply with the Apostolic Constitution "Ex Corde Ecclesiae" in running and managing their schools, and that the school spirits and cultures conform to Catholic tradition and culture.

Since this document needs to be agreed upon by the CRBC, the Apostolic Nunciature believes that the CRBC can designate who will take the responsibility stated in Article 4:1 "to maintain and strengthen its Catholic identity" and then decide the title of the person, identity and status e.g. Local ordinary (地方主教), President of the Board of trustees (學校董事長) 或Chancellor (校長). Moreover, the English text of Article 4:5 states, "The Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor of a Catholic Higher Education Institution are to be practicing Catholics of distinguished character," which clearly refers to the laity, not bishops nor the clergy.

Resolution: Art. 4:1 in Chinese is changed to "Local ordinary"(地方主教).

In the English translation of Art. 4:5, "Chancellor" is changed to "President" and "Vice-Chancellor" is changed to "Vice-President".

I.D: The CRBC Pastoral Letter for the Year 2015

Explanation:

The Holy See has already declared 2015 as the "Year of Consecrated Life." During the joint meeting of bishops and major religious superiors on March 31st, it was agreed that the title of the 2015 Pastoral Letter would be: "Consecrated Life to Serve the New Evangelization." Furthermore, February 2 is the "World Day for Consecrated Life".

Therefore, men and women religious representatives are requested to provide, as soon as possible, articles for reflection regarding "Consecrated Life" and specific cooperative activities between the dioceses and religious communities.

Resolution: Fr. Luis Gendron (SJ) is entrusted with the responsibility of preparing an overall plan and serving as the chief editor. A report should be presented during the Autumn Plenary Assembly.

I.E: Establish guidelines for invitation of foreign speakers to give talks to the local Church

Explanation:

If a lay person from abroad plans to come back to Taiwan to give a keynote speech, the present practice is that one looks for friends (leaders of lay organizations) from different dioceses and arranges his or her itinerary and venue. In order to ensure that the speaker and the contents of his/her talk (e.g. doctrine, spirituality, ethics, morality etc.), do not mislead the faithful, the CRBC or each diocese should establish a policy for speakers, setting qualification guidelines to avoid creating confusion and even harm.

Means: Each diocese should set its own qualification requirements based on their needs.

Resolution: The Secretariat will gather information for reference about the practices of other bishops' conferences. This information will be reported during the Autumn Plenary Assembly.

Proposition II: The Commission for Sacred Liturgy

II.A: Recommend that each diocese create a diocesan-level promotion team for the veneration of the Blessed Sacrament

Explanation:

The Episcopal Commission for Sacred Liturgy has already created a Promotion Team for the devotion of the Holy Eucharist. To facilitate communication and to promote more effectively this veneration, each diocese should assign a person or create a small team dedicated to this task.

Means:

Each diocese should implement the resolution agreed upon as Proposal A of the Commission for Sacred Liturgy during the 2012 CRBC Autumn Plenary Assembly with regard to the veneration of the Blessed Sacrament and formation on the Sacrament of the Eucharist, and the organization of National Eucharistic Congresses. The second "Means" states: To achieve these goals, according to the situation of each diocese, it is recommended that a "Holy Eucharist Promotion Committee" be established (from the Commission for Sacred Liturgy or Pastoral Commission), or a person be designated to have the primary responsibility of achieving this goal.

Resolution: Approved.

II.B: Recommend that each diocese create a "Promotion Group for Blessing and Praying for the Dying"

Explanation:

The purpose of a "Promotion Group for Blessing and Praying for the Dying" is so that the laity can form a service group which gives witness to the Catholic Church. With the risen Christ as the center, hearts can be opened to receive grace from the Lord. Through the communion of the prayers of the faithful, the dying will be entrusted into the hands of God the Father. The relatives and friends accompanying the deceased can deepen their faith in Jesus Christ. Trust in the salvation of God can

develop, communion with the departed can be expressed, and union with God on the Day of Judgment can be anticipated. While rendering service, opportunities to evangelize can be found.

Means:

The "Promotion Group for Blessing and Praying for the Dying" of the Episcopal Commission for Sacred Liturgy can provide formation sessions based on the needs of the diocese. Moreover, they can share with others the structure of their group and their experiences. If a diocese has a need, they can contact this group at the Episcopal Commission for the Sacred Liturgy.

Resolution: Approved.

II.C: Following the approved resolutions of the CRBC 2012 Spring Plenary Assembly and Article X of a notice issued in May of the same year, because a statement of the Commission for Sacred Liturgy was incorrect or misleading, it is hereby corrected. The article is as follows: (need to revise the italicized and underscored sentences)

Explanation:

With regard to a non-Catholic baptized Christian receiving Holy Communion in the Catholic Church, it must be in accordance with the Code of Canon Law 844 and the Directory for the Application of Principles and Norms on Ecumenism Nos. 124 and 131. Thus, "Catholic ministers administer the sacraments licitly to Catholic members of the Christian faithful alone, who likewise receive them licitly from Catholic ministers alone" (Can. 844:1). However: "Whenever necessity requires it or true spiritual advantage suggests it, and provided that danger of error or of indifferentism is avoided, the Christian faithful for whom it is physically or morally impossible to approach a Catholic minister

are permitted to receive the sacraments of penance, Eucharist, and anointing of the sick from non-Catholic ministers in whose Churches these sacraments are valid" (Can. 844:2). On the other hand, under the same conditions: "Catholic ministers administer the sacraments of penance, Eucharist, and anointing of the sick licitly to members of Eastern Churches which do not have full communion with the Catholic Church if they seek such on their own accord and are properly disposed. This is also valid for members of other Churches which in the judgment of the Apostolic See are in the same condition in regard to the sacraments as these Eastern Churches" (Can. 844:3). And especially: "If the danger of death is present or if, in the judgment of the diocesan bishop or conference of bishops, some other grave necessity urges it, Catholic ministers administer these same sacraments licitly also to other Christians not having full communion with the Catholic Church, who cannot approach a minister of their own community and who seek such on their own accord, provided that they manifest Catholic faith in respect to these sacraments and are properly disposed" (Can. 844:4). However, pay special attention to: "A Catholic who legitimately wishes to communicate with Eastern Christians must respect the Eastern discipline as much as possible and refrain from communicating if that Church restricts sacramental communion to its own members to the exclusion of others" (Principles and Norms of Ecumenism No. 124).

Means:

- 1. Since Canon 844:3 is not in the same condition as Canon 844:2, thus "*On the other hand, under the same conditions* (反之,在相同的情况 下) will be changed to "**Moreover**"(另外).
- 2. To avoid semantic misunderstanding, "<u>And especially</u>" (<u>而尤其</u> 是) will be changed to "**Furthermore**" (再者).

Resolution: Approved.

II.D: Rev. Louis Gendron, President of Fu Jen Faculty of Theology of St. Robert Bellarmine, is seeking permission to give Holy Communion to students of the Taiwan Episcopal Church studying at the Faculty of Theology

Means: Request that Fr. Luis Gendron attend and discuss the situation during the meeting.

Resolution:

Request Fr. Gendron to present a report to explain matters concerning the reception of Holy Communion by students of the Taiwan Episcopal Church studying at Fu Jen Faculty of Theology of St. Robert Bellarmine. The CRBC will consult with the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples and will make a decision based on their recommendations.

Proposition III: The Commission for Aborigine Apostolate

III.A: Request for approval to hire a part-time secretary

Explanation:

- 1. At present, the important tasks of the Commission for Aborigine Apostolate are as follows: to assist each diocese in raising funds during the "Indigenous Peoples' Day", to plan activities for children and youth, a get-together for priests, the national pastoral conference for indigenous people, the formation of lay persons, etc., and to apply for subsidy. The resolutions of each national pastoral conference and the formation of volunteers urgently need an assistant to help carry out these tasks.
- 2. Qualifications of the assistant secretary are: Catholic, already received basic formation in evangelization, experienced in organizing Church activities, capable of handling computer and network information.

Resolution: Approved to hire a part-time secretary.

Proposition IV: The Commission for the Clergy (Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary)

IV.A: The construction of the Regional Seminary reported an increment of NT\$5,000,000 in the budget

Explanation:

- 1. (...)
- 2. Based on the 71st work-negotiation meeting between the Regional Seminary and the Architecture World Construction Company(統營營 造股份公司), after bargaining, the Architecture World Construction Company informed their Head Office not to change the amount of donation as stated in the original contract. Other agreements should be implemented according to previous resolutions. Finally, after negotiations, it is confirmed by Deputy General Manager Wen Wenquan that an additional sum of 5M (including tax) will be paid. (Appendix 2)
- 3. (...)

Means: Request the CRBC and Architecture World Construction Company to confirm the additional cost of 5M (including tax) and related payment matters.

Resolution: Agreed and approved.

IV.B: An evaluation on priests and professors of the Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary (TCRS) via internet online questionnaire

Explanation:

- 1. To provide suitable candidates as formators at the Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary, an evaluation on formators will be formulated based on the guidance of priests and professors. For the formators, this evaluation can serve as guideline for self-criticism and the establishing of the Church's formation system, in order to do better for the formation. It could help to identify the kind of formators needed by the Church and the Regional Seminary. The search for suitable formators should not be idealistic or too general, but must be done in prayer and in dialogue!
- 2. (...)
- 3. (...)
- 4. Internet website system will be used for answering questions. Furthermore, the webpage will automatically collate relevant information to form a report as a reference for priests and teachers (it can provide browse editing privileges in the network).

Resolution:

Approved. Present the results during the Autumn Plenary Assembly.

IV.C: Encourage each diocese to carefully assess candidates for priesthood

Explanation:

To ensure that candidates are suitable to undergo formation at the Regional Seminary, each diocese is encouraged to follow the edited Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary Application for Admission Procedure approved by the bishops in 2007 CRBC Plenary Assembly.

Means:

- 1. Letters and relevant documents have already been sent to the priests in-charge of vocations in each diocese. If there are other requests, please contact the Vocations Promotion Center. (Appendix 1-12)
- 2. Following the custom of the Regional Seminary, the deadline for application for new students is on August 15th. On that day, there will be interviews of new students and an explanation of the Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary Program. Each diocese is requested to cooperate and make arrangements.

Resolution: Accepted and approved.

IV.D: Request that each diocese follow the instructions of the Holy See concerning the "Criteria for the Discernment of Vocations with regard to Persons with Homosexual Tendencies in view of their Admission to the Seminary and to Holy Orders" and its implementation during the formation period.

Explanation:

- 1. To ensure that candidates are suitable to undergo formation at the Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary, each diocese is asked to follow the "Instruction Concerning the Criteria for the Discernment of Vocations with regard to Persons with Homosexual Tendencies in view of their Admission to the Seminary and to Holy Orders" approved and decreed by the Congregation for Catholic Education in 2005.
- 2. According to the program for application for admission to TCRS, there should be a "companionship period" of at least six months with each vocation candidate. If there is any relevant manifestation during this period of observation, the diocese will decide whether or not the candidate should be sent to the Regional Seminary for formation.

Means:

1. Enclosed is the "Instruction Concerning the Criteria for the Discernment of Vocations with regard to Persons with Homosexual Tendencies in view of their Admission to the Seminary and to Holy Orders" document (Appendix 1).

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- 2. Related documents will also be published and discussed during the Vocations Forum on May 18, 2014. If there are any other needs, the Vocations Promotion Center can be contacted.
- 3. Following the custom of the Regional Seminary, the deadline for application for new students is on August 15th. On that day, there will be interviews of new students and an explanation of the Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary Program. Each diocese is requested to cooperate and make arrangements.

Resolution:

Each diocesan bishop should announce to all its priests the above mentioned Church principles and their importance. During the sacrament of penance and while conversing with or companioning possible candidates, priests should try their best to dissuade those with homosexual tendencies from pursing the vocation of priesthood according to their conscience.

IV.E: Yearly ongoing formation for the clergy from August 18-22, 2014

Rationale:

To learn about the social status of homosexuals in Taiwan, the teachings and stance of the Church, and to share the pastoral experience in Hong Kong.

Explanation:

- 1. This ongoing formation event will be organized by the Episcopal Commission for the Clergy, co-organized by the Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary, and assisted by the Taiwan Catholic Canon Law Society. All priests in Taiwan can have an opportunity for ongoing formation. The event will be designed especially for those priests serving in parishes.
- 2. Content of the course: Seeking the best way for the local Church to proceed by talking and reflecting together on the following topics with the priest participants: the social status of homosexuals in Taiwan, alternative marriage and family formation legislative demands etc., an explanation of the Church's stance on related topics such as humanity, marriage and family, gender, etc., and the sharing of the pastoral concerns and work in Hong Kong and abroad etc.

Means:

- 1. Speakers: Fr. Stephen Chan (陳滿鴻神父) and team members (Hong Kong); Fr. Caesar Albert Rego(利志誠神父), Neocatechumenate; Fr. Damien Lim (林源恆神父), Opus Dei; Prof. Chi Ming (齊明老師), Fu Jen Catholic University Faculty of Theology
- 2. Topics: Pastoral care for homosexuals and the stance of the Catholic Church; natural law on marriage, on family, on sexuality; and teachings on Christian anthropology etc.; current status in Taiwan society, civil and legislative demands etc. (pls see appendix 1 for title and abstract) Date: 2014.08.18 -22 (Monday-Friday), five days. (Course flow chart see Appendix 2)
- 3. Target Audience: Parish priests are especially invited to participate; religious priests are welcome and free to join.

4. Venue: Taiwan Catholic Regional Seminary at No. 58 Santai Rd., Xinzhuang, New Taipei City [24255]

Note: The CRBC Section for Family has arranged for the group of speakers from Hong Kong to share with the faithful on the topic "Pastoral Concern for Homosexuals". This will take place on Saturday morning, August 23, 2014, which is the day after the ongoing formation of priests.

Resolution:

Approved. Parish priests who are 50 years old and above are encouraged to attend, while those who are below 50 years old are required to attend.

Proposition V: The Commission for Evangelization, Section for the Family

V.A: The Catholic Church continues to participate in the "Taiwan Religious Groups Care for the Family Alliance"

Explanation:

- 1. Last year, to stop the "Alternative Family Formation Bill" from gaining consensus in the society, and to keep the Legislative Yuan from making a haste decision without ample discussion, the Catholic Church and other religious groups in Taiwan together formed the "Taiwan Religious Groups Care for the Family Alliance". Furthermore, through the joint efforts of a petition campaign and a big demonstration on November 30, 2014, they indeed effectively made the Legislative Yuan temporarily set aside the hearing of the bill.
- 2. While participating in this action, some opposing voices could be heard within the Church because remarks were made by the Alliance

Group that did not completely represent the teachings of the Catholic Church. Thus, the Catholic Church should sever its membership with the Alliance Group and not join anymore. The Catholic Church should independently voice its stance through its own communication channels.

- 3. When the CRBC Section for Family was involved with the Alliance Group, as they looked at the long-term plans of the latter, they discovered that the principle of trying to arouse the society to give importance to family and life education etc., agrees with that of the Catholic Church. Without subsequent participation and cooperation, one cannot really judge whether we can collaborate with other religious groups or not.
- 4. Because of this situation the CRBC Section for Family convened the "Diocesan Commission for Family (Section for Family) Spring Meeting" on March 29, 2014 and specially presented this issue for discussion. The majority of the members of the Diocesan Commission for Family (Section for Family) were of the opinion that to join with other religious groups in voicing one's stance actually concentrates resources and confronts the society with the severity of the issues. If we share the same views then we should continue to participate in the Alliance. Furthermore, the Catholic Church should firmly convey the stance that she will stay in the Alliance Group, and allow the Catholic Church in Taiwan, through its participation and coordination with all sectors to accomplish the mission entrusted to her by Jesus Christ.

Means:

1. Continue to send representatives to participate in the meetings and discussions of the "Taiwan Religious Groups Care for the Family Alliance". Furthermore, support, advocate for and participate in the activities organized by this Alliance Group itself and in activities initiated by these religious groups, as long as the activities do not violate the teachings of the Catholic Church.

2. The long-term plans of the Alliance Group are not only to arouse the society to emphasize the importance of families and related issues, and involve not only the CRBC Section for Family and diocesan Commission for Family (Section for Family). In relation to life education, it also involves the Episcopal Commission for Education and Culture. Thus, aside from the participation of the Section for Family of CRBC, the CRBC Commission for Education and Culture also has an opportunity to collaborate and participate.

Resolution: Continue to participate in the "Taiwan Religious Groups Care for Family Alliance". Each diocese should create a pastoral care team to work with those who have same sex orientation.

V.B: The CRBC Section for Family will collaborate with the St. Gianna Pro-Life Center in Hsinchu in organizing conferences to protect and care for life and family from September 16-21, 2014.

Explanation:

- 1. The "Asian Protect and Care for Life and Family Groups" will hold its 9th Conference in 2015. Taiwan will host the conference. The CRBC Section for Family and the St. Gianna Pro-Life Center of the Hsinchu diocese will work together to plan for the conference and oversee related matters.
- 2. In order to help people have a better understanding of the true meaning of protecting and caring for life and the family, the CRBC Section for Family and the St. Gianna Pro-Life Center of the Hsinchu diocese will work together to organize conferences for priests from September 16-18, 2014 and for the faithful from September 19-21, 2014.

3. All diocesan Commissions for the Family (Sections for the Family) are also invited to participate in these conferences. Support for and participation in these conferences is strongly encouraged. These conferences were already approved during the Spring Meeting on March 29, 2014 by all the diocesan Commissions for the Family (Sections for the Family), and afterwards families were invited to participate.

Means: Encourage all dioceses to support these conferences as much as possible, and send suitable priests and faithful to attend the conferences.

Resolution: Agreed and approved.

V.C: To help the faithful understand what pastoral knowledge is needed to care for people who are attracted to others of the same sex, the CRBC Section for the Family will organize a conference in the morning of August 23, 2014 in the 2nd floor conference room of the CRBC Secretariat Administrative Bldg.

Explanation:

- 1. Due to the endless social debate on the issue of same-sex marriage, the faithful often feel at a loss when dealing with this issue.
- 2. In order to help the faithful know how to deal properly with persons of same sex orientation, and to further understand various pastoral approaches, the "Team for the Pastoral Care of Homosexuals" from the Hong Kong diocese has been specially invited to come and share their practical experiences.
- 3. Hopefully this sharing of experiences will help the dioceses in creating groups for the pastoral evangelization of persons attracted to

others of the same-sex.

Means: Encourage each diocese to support, as much as possible, this conference, and to send suitable faithful to attend the conference.

Resolution: Agreed and approved.

VARIA:

1. The Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples approved "to modify the limit of competence for alienation of ecclesiastical properties" to US\$2,000,000.

Explanation:

Code of Canon 638 §3. "For the validity of alienation and of any other affair in which the patrimonial condition of a juridic person can worsen, the written permission of the competent superior with the consent of the council is required.

Nevertheless, if it concerns an affair which exceeds the amount defined by the Holy See for each region, or things given to the Church by vow, or things precious for artistic or historical reasons, the permission of the Holy See itself is also required." As a result, religious communities should be informed.

Resolution: Send a letter to the Regional Association of Major Religious Superiors of Men and Women and inform them of this new regulation.

2. One of the resolutions of the 2012 CRBC Autumn Plenary Assembly was: "In principle, once every two or three years a National Eucharistic Congress can be organized. The date and venue of each National Eucharistic Congress will be decided during the CRBC plenary assemblies."

Explanation:

There should be a new theme for each Eucharistic Congress, while maintaining the continuity of a series of Eucharistic Congresses. All of the themes should help the faith life of the faithful to mature. There is a need to re-define the National Eucharistic Congress, and decide the themes of the Eucharistic Congresses for the next 15 years after the June 7 Eucharistic Congress.

Resolution: Entrust to the Commission for the Sacred Liturgy the responsibility of writing proposals and making a report during the Autumn Plenary Assembly.

3. To reiterate with President Ma Ying-jeou the following stance: "Respect for life, abolish the death penalty".

Explanation:

Fr. Willy Ollevier, CICM, the Coordinator General for Justice, Peace and Integrity of Creation from the Association of Major Religious Superiors in Taiwan, when presenting a report to Caritas-Taiwan suggested that the CRBC write a letter with joint signatures to President Ma Ying-jeou, to give moral support to Chiou Ho-Shun, a convict sentenced to death.

Resolution: Approved. Fr. Willy Ollevier will draft the letter.


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
